


Jurassic Visit

#### A 'Let's Read Together!' Book




Next, we saw some meat eaters who were fighting. We quickly hid because we did not want to be spotted. We had to stay still and be silent until the herd went by.






























Today, we are learning to read and write words that contain **ow** and **oe** saying /oa/.

hoe doe goes once please

































## Ben's Sticker Book

This makes a great whiteboard activity!


Click 'Check' to reveal which page has **ow** words and which page has **oe** words.

I thought it would be fun to go back in time to see some reptiles like my plastic dinosaur, Steg.






















### **Mini Book Printing Instructions**

#### Instructions

- 3. Layer the pages together, ensuring that the numbers at the top of each page are in order.
- 4. Fold lengthwise along the dotted line and staple together.
