After a few seconds, Ben and Sam were safely back home in Ben's bedroom. It was almost as though they had never been away.



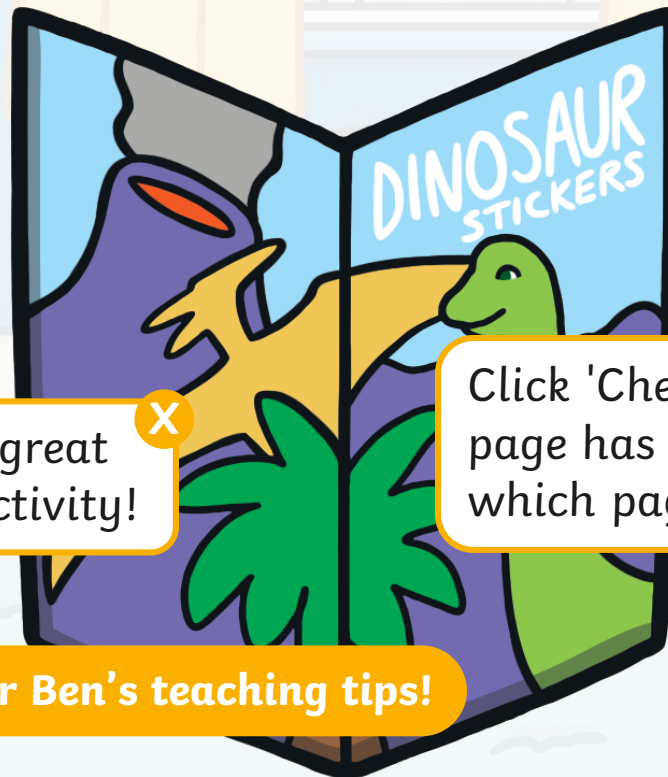
“Thank you!” said Sam, once she had taken a deep breath.

This makes a great whiteboard activity!

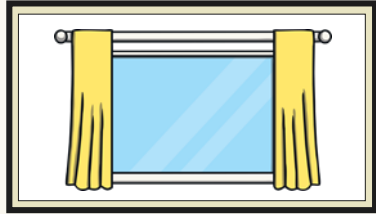
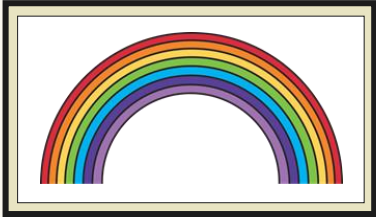

When Mum left, Ben got straight to work. Ben thought he would write down his adventure to share with Jake at school tomorrow.

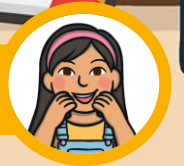

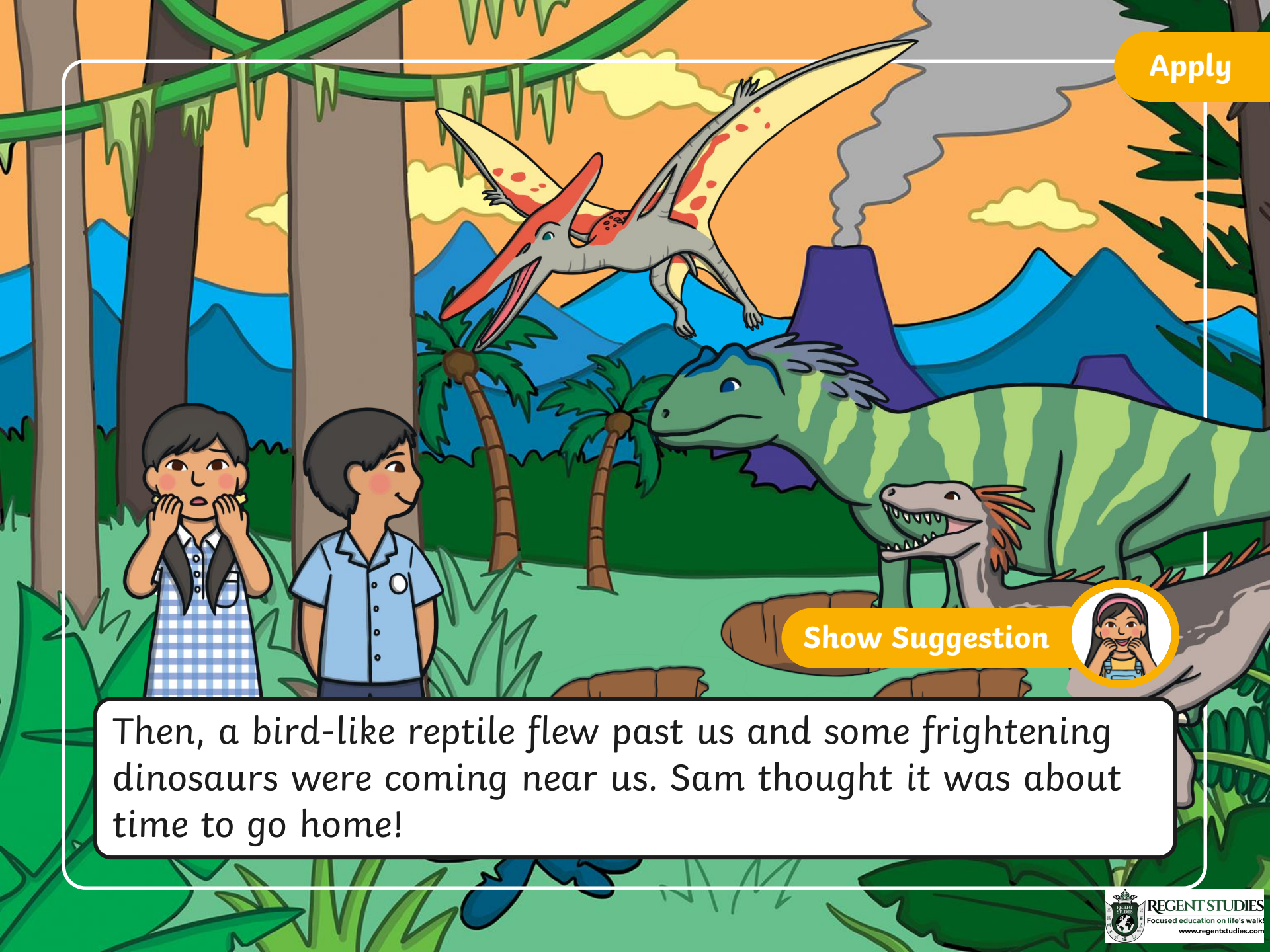
