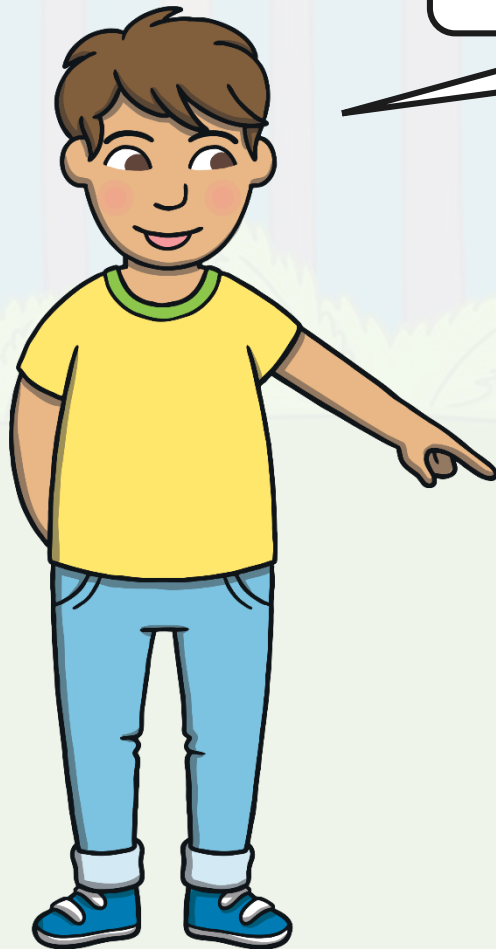

"I am not too sure. Let's keep walking on for a bit and see where we end up," replied Kit.



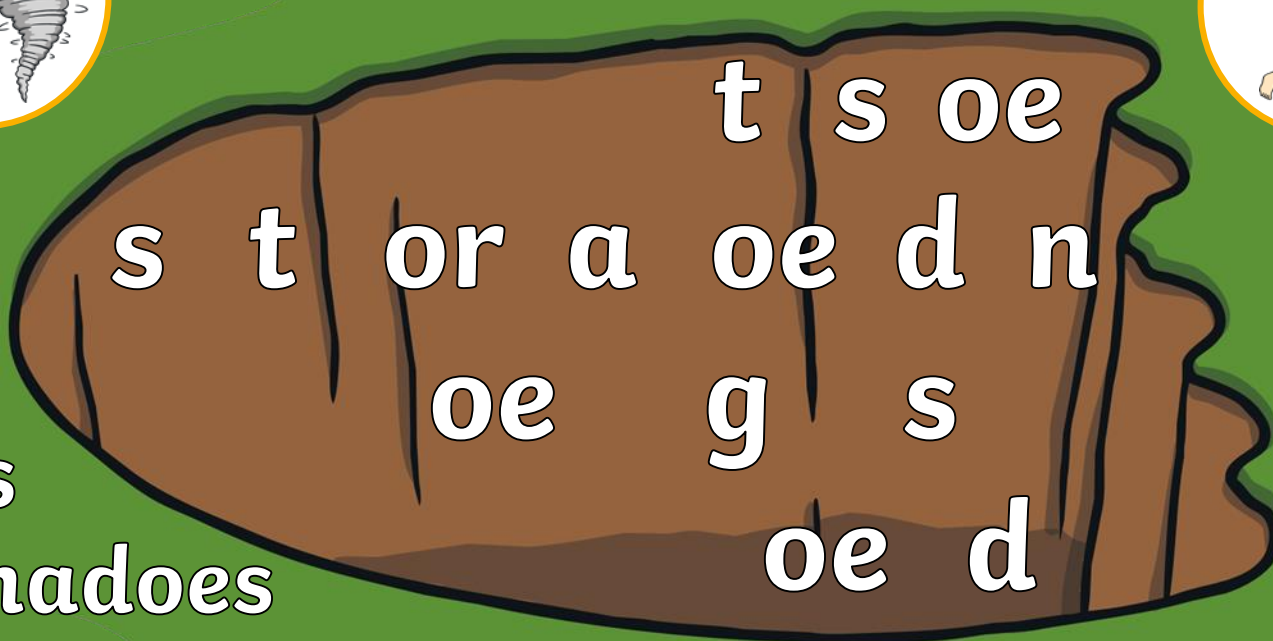

Find something in the picture that has the **oe** sound. Can you spell the word? Write it down. Click on the **oe** picture to reveal the word.

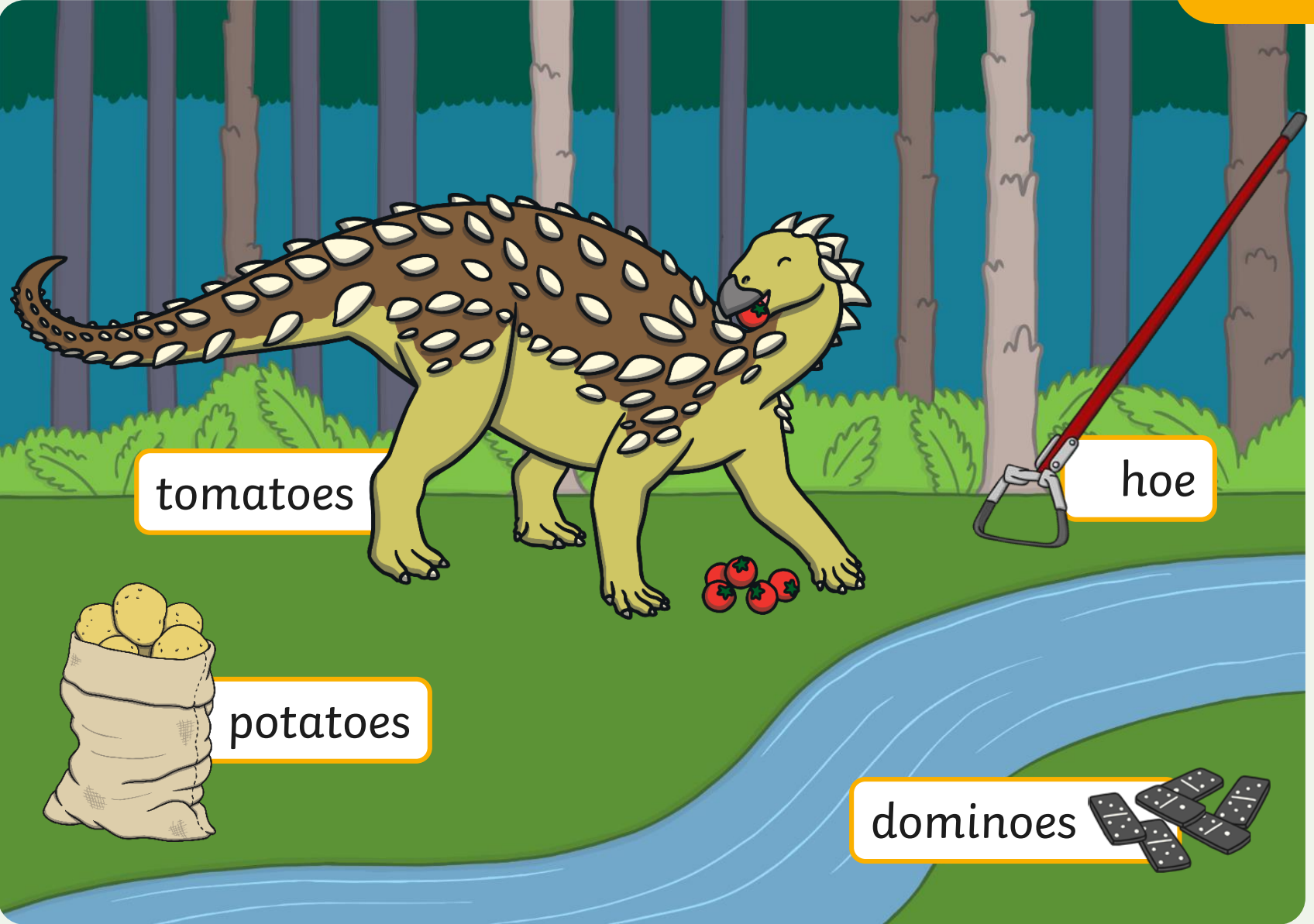

Sam cannot believe that these holes are dinosaur footprints! What does she say to Kit about them? Write a sentence to match.

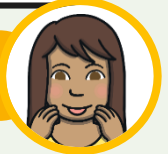
