

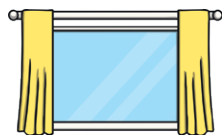


This week, we are learning to read and spell words containing *ow* and *oe* saying *loal*.

### Top Tip

The graphemes 'ow' and 'oe' can both make the same sounds as 'oa'. They are both most commonly used when the *loal* sound comes at the end or near the end of a word, e.g. bow, toe.
