

Using Full Stops, Question Marks and Exclamation Marks:

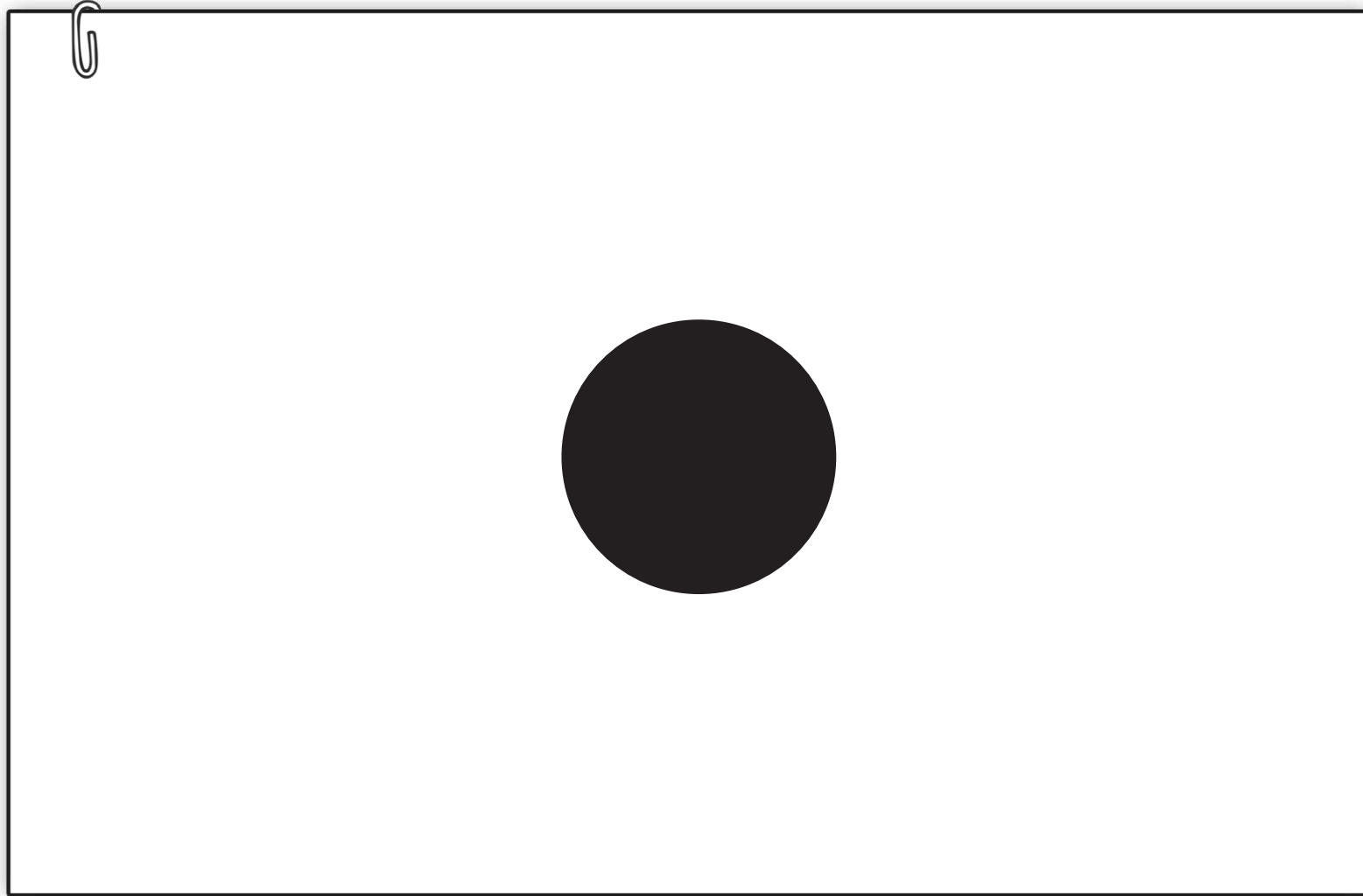
A Punctuation Game

- The children with the correct punctuation mark to finish the sentence stand up and say the name of the correct punctuation mark after the sentence has been read.

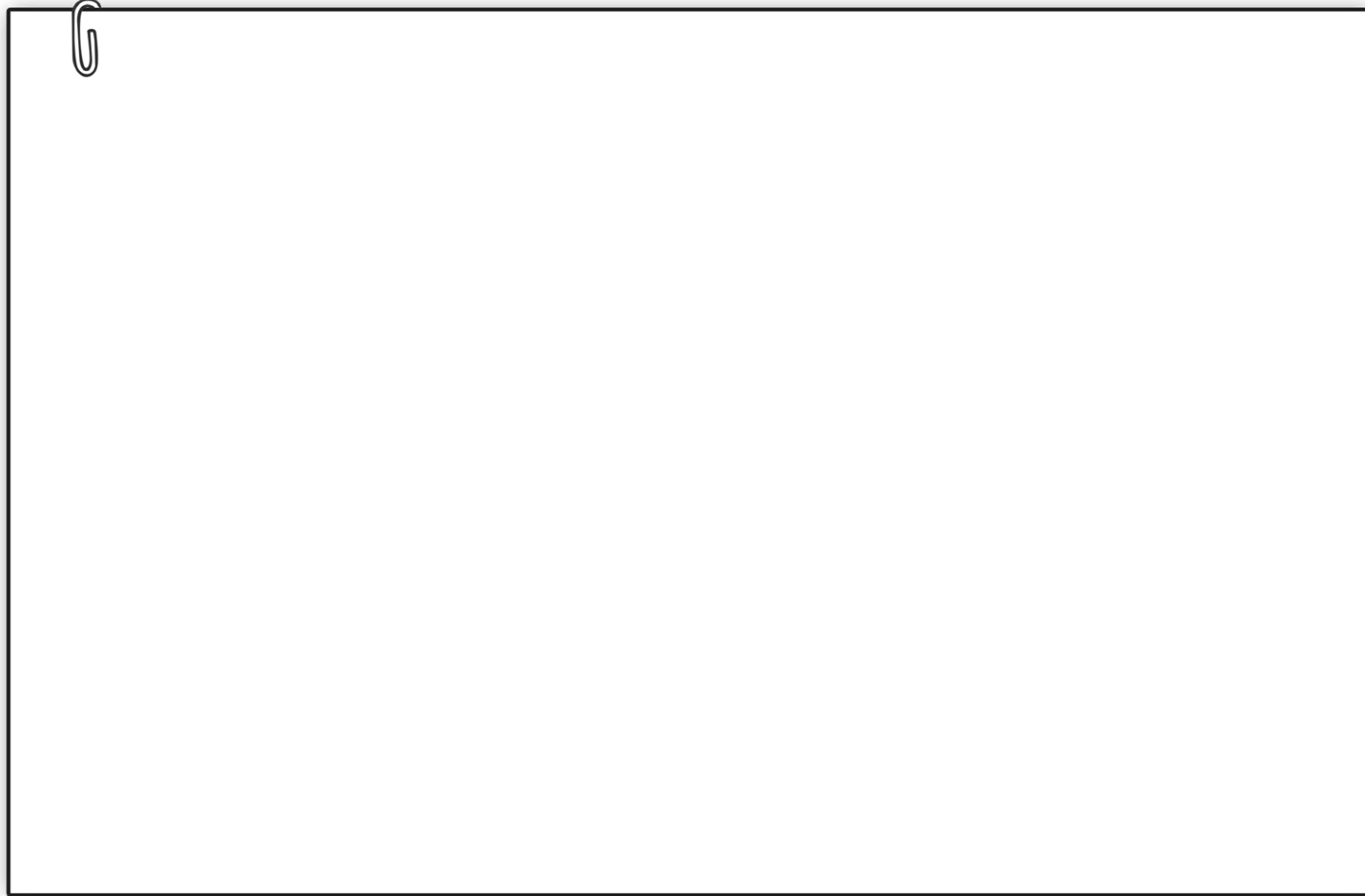
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
