






# SPaG: Capital Letter for Personal Pronoun I

<p><b>Aim:</b> To be able to use a capital letter for the personal pronoun 'I'. I can use a capital letter for the word 'I'.</p>	<p><b>Prior Learning:</b> It will be helpful if children know the uppercase alphabet (letter name and formation).</p>	<p><b>Resources:</b> <a href="#">Lesson Pack</a></p>
<p><b>Success Criteria:</b> I can use a capital letter for 'I' when I am writing about myself.</p>	<p><b>Key/New Words:</b> Capital letter, name, important, personal pronoun.</p>	<p><b>Preparation:</b> <a href="#">Capital Letter for I Activity Sheet</a> 1 per child <a href="#">Application Activity Sheet Personal Pronoun I</a> 1 per child</p>

	<p><b>Introductory Activity: Capital Letter for I</b> When do we use capital letters? (<i>beginning of a sentence /names etc..</i>) We also use it when we talk about ourselves and we say the word I. I might say (<i>emphasise 'I'</i>) "I am a teacher" or "I like books". Look at the <a href="#">Lesson Presentation</a>.</p>
	<p><b>Independent Focused Activity: Composing a Sentence</b> Children to write three sentences about themselves using the personal pronoun "I". Complete question 1 on the <a href="#">Capital Letter for I Activity Sheet</a> (differentiated through support. LA may need help with reading).</p>
	<p><b>Review Activity: Capital Letter for I</b> Read aloud the sentences on the <a href="#">Lesson Presentation</a>. Can the children work out what is missing? Talk to your partner. Teacher to take children's answers and reveal the answers on the <a href="#">Lesson Presentation</a>.</p>

	<p><b>Consolidation Activity: Editing Text</b> Children to complete question 2 on the <a href="#">Capital Letter for I Activity Sheet</a>. Children to read the sentences and adjust the capital letters accordingly. LA children to be supported with the reading.</p>
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	<p><b>Assessment/Application Activity</b> Children to complete <a href="#">Application Sheet Personal Pronoun I</a>. Teacher to assess if they have correctly used 'I' within their sentences.</p>
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
