# SPaG: Capital Letter for Personal Pronoun I

Aim: To be able to use a capital letter for the personal pronoun 'I'. I can use a capital letter for the word 'I'.	Prior Learning: It will be helpful if children know the uppercase alphabet (letter name and formation).	Resources: Lesson Pack

### Introductory Activity: Capital Letter for I

When do we use capital letters? (beginning of  $\alpha$  sentence/names etc..) We also use it when we talk about ourselves and we say the word I. I might say (emphasise 'I') "I am a teacher" or "I like books". Look at the Lesson Presentation.



#### **Independent Focused Activity: Composing a Sentence**

Children to write three sentences about themselves using the personal pronoun "I".

Complete question 1 on the Capital Letter for I Activity Sheet (differentiated through support. LA may need help with

reading).



## Review Activity: Capital Letter for I

Read aloud the sentences on the Lesson Presentation. Can the children work out what is missing? Talk to your partner. Teacher to take children's answers and reveal the answers on the Lesson Presentation.



## **Consolidation Activity: Editing Text**

Children to complete question 2 on the Capital Letter for I Activity Sheet. Children to read the sentences and adjust the capital letters accordingly. LA children to be supported with the reading.



#### **Assessment/Application Activity**

Children to complete Application Sheet Personal Pronoun I. Teacher to assess if they have correctly used 'I' within their sentences.
