Prior Learning: Children will have discussed and recorded the weather in lesson 2 and build a weather station.

#### **Learning Sequence**



**Summer:** In talk partners children discuss their experiences of summer. Use the questions on the **Lesson Presentation** to help structure their discussion.





**Summer Photos:** Look at the **Summer Photos** and discuss them. Are children able to describe what the weather is usually like in summer?





**Our Weather Station:** Remind children of the weather station they built during the previous unit. Can they remember what it is measuring and how? Remind children of the tools being used to measure the weather and the units they use (for example the rain gauge measures the rainfall in mm).





**Weather Report:** Children use the differentiated **Weather Report Activity Sheet** to record the weather for today. (Monitor the weather for the rest of that week using the weather station and record on the weather chart each day). Use the **Weather Symbols Prompt Sheet** to remind children of the weather symbols if needed. Are children able to make observations about the weather?





Children use the writing frame and word bank to support.



Children complete the sheet using the word bank if needed.



Children complete the sheet, explaining any changes people may make to adapt to the different weather conditions.





**Summer Weather:** (Discuss this after children have recorded the weather everyday over the week). What do they notice about the weather this week? What has the temperature been? What has the weather been like? How have they dealt with the weather, for example what have they been wearing? Are children able to describe the summer weather? If you have the **Weather Report Activity Sheets** from autumn, winter and spring, compare them with these. What do they notice about the temperature and the rainfall etc. across the seasons?

#### **Task**it

Forecastit: Children could use the Weather Forecasting Role Play Pack to create their own spring weather forecast.

Createit: Children could imagine they were on their summer holiday and use the Postcard Templates to create their own

postcards telling friends back home what the weather has been like and what they have been doing.

**Bottleit:** Children could create summer in a bottle by collecting small objects which they associate with summer (such as seashells and pieces of yellow paper to represent the sun) in a small (washed) transparent drinks bottle. See the

Seasons Discovery Bottles Adult Guidance Sheet for more ideas. Children could then share these with the class, explaining why they put their objects in their bottle.
