Lions roar to communicate, or talk, with each other. A male lion roars to let other animals know that they are not allowed in his territory. A territory is another name for land. A lion's roar can also help lost lions find their home. Lions do not roar when they are hunting because their prey will run away. Often you can hear a lion roaring at night. If you are lucky enough, you might be able to hear a lion roar at a zoo or even in Africa. It's a beautiful sound!









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Why do zebras have stripes?

No one really knows! However, scientists have come up with three different guesses. Some say that zebras who live in warmer places have more stripes. This helps them to keep cool, or reduce body temperature. Other scientists say that it helps the zebra confuse its predators because it camouflages them with the background. When an animal camouflages, you can't easily find them. Finally, scientists have concluded that maybe it helps the animals recognize each other. So the next time someone asks you, "Why do zebras have stripes?" Simply say, for many different reasons.

Why do elephants have big ears?

Elephants live in very hot climates, so they use their big, floppy ears to stay cool. They work like a giant fan. When the elephant flaps its ears, it creates a light breeze, or cool wind. It's like stepping in front of a fan on a hot summer day - you feel much better. If the elephants don't want to flap their ears, they roll in the mud. Sometimes they dip in a pool of water or spray their body by using their trunks. Can you imagine having ears like an elephant? That would be very silly!



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Why do giraffes have long necks?

Giraffes like to munch on a lot of leaves. Their long necks help them reach the leaves up high on trees. This reduces competition for food because a lot of smaller animals can't reach the higher leaves. Giraffes also need their long necks to fight. This is called "necking." On top of eating and fighting, a giraffe's long neck helps scare away predators because their long necks make them look tall and big.

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Why do lions live in groups?

Lions are the only cats that live in groups. This is called **prides**. There are usually up to 15 lions in one pride, but most prides are small. When lions live together, they form a family. The male lion protects the territory so no one attacks them. And when the female lion goes hunting, the male lion will **guard** the cabs. A pride also makes hunting easy. It is much easier to catch an animal if two or more lions work together instead of hunting alone.



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Why do bears hibernate in the winter?

When the winter months arrive, bears hibernate. To hibernate means to "sleep." The temperature outside is very cold in the winter and food is scarce. So, before the winter arrives, bears eat more than usual to store up body fat. When they hibernate during the winter, they use up this extra body fat as food. If they didn't have this extra body fat or if they had to search for food in winter, they would starve.





In order to find food and water fast in such an empty land, the animal needs to move fast. Therefore, hopping makes it easy for the kangaroo to find food and water quickly. 
