

Teacher Directions

I love using stories like this one to give my students practice with different “WH” comprehension questions and to collect data on their comprehension skills.

Included in this packet are 2 versions of the story and 2 different question formats. In the picture format, the story is presented as a book and the questions are on individual cards with pictures. In the text only format, the story is presented on one page, and the questions are presented in a multiple choice format in which the student circles the correct answer.

There is also a data sheet included to record how the student does answering the comprehension questions, and can also be used to assess listening comprehension (no text presented to the student, everything is read by the teacher).
