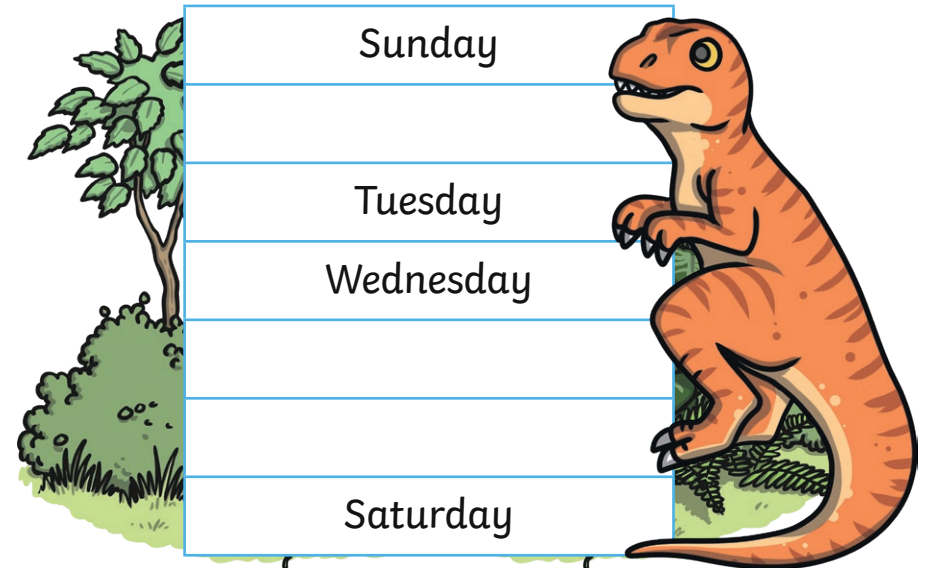

Diving into Mastery – Deepest Adult Guidance with Question Prompts

Children should know that there are seven days in a week and be able to sequence them. They should be able to use the vocabulary ‘today’, ‘yesterday’ and ‘tomorrow’ to say which day comes before and after a given day.

Which days of the week are the weekend?

What did she do at the weekend?

What did she do on Friday?

Which day is before Friday? What did Tess the T. rex do that day?

Which day is before Tuesday? What did she do on that day?

Which day is after Tuesday? What did she do on that day?

Which day is left? What did she do on that day?
