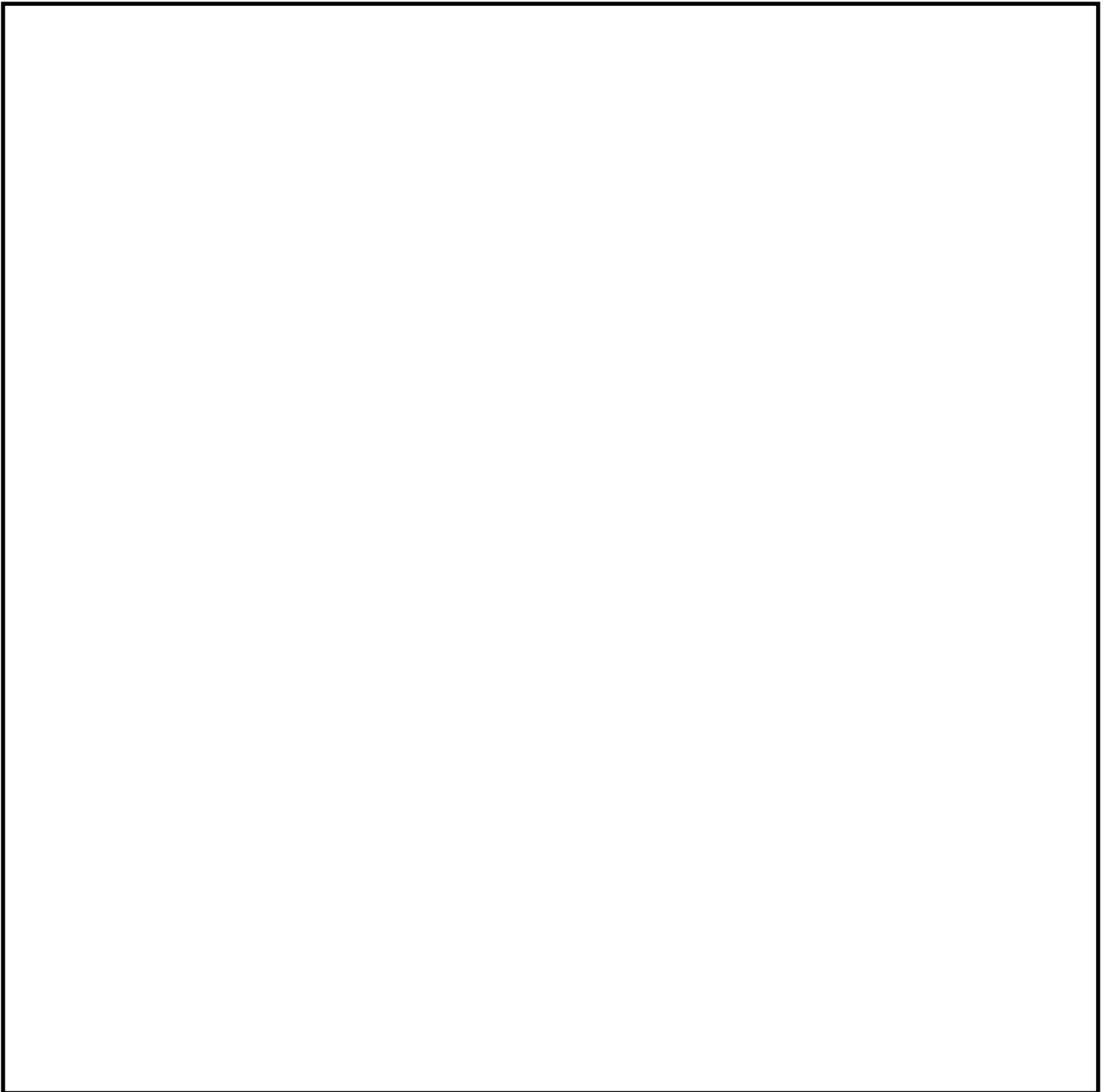


Copy Cat!

How are you going to get your picture from the camera device to the printer? Will you have to use a computer?

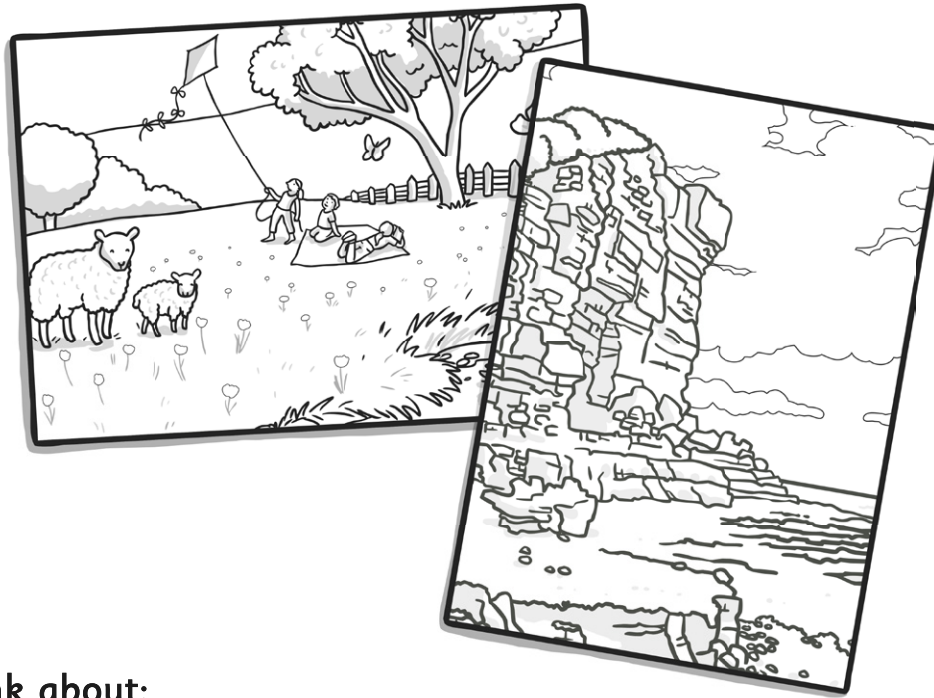
How do you want your picture to look on the page? Can you change how big it is or the quality of the picture when it is printed?
