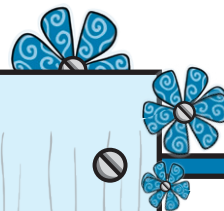

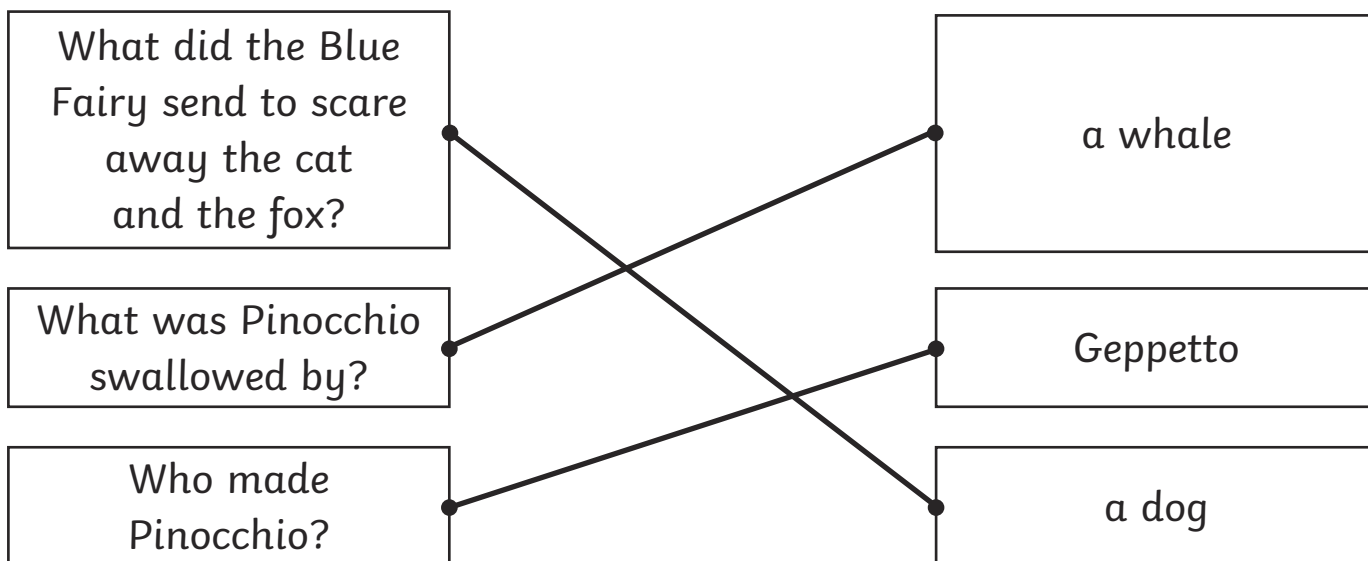

Pinocchio

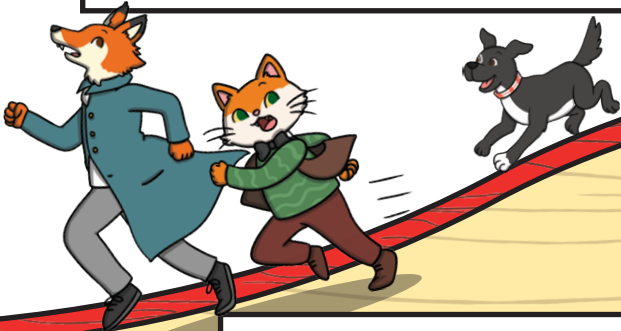


There was once an elderly man named Geppetto who lived alone and longed for a child. Geppetto made a puppet and called it Pinocchio.



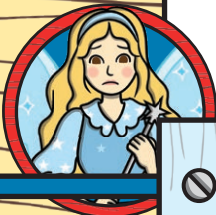

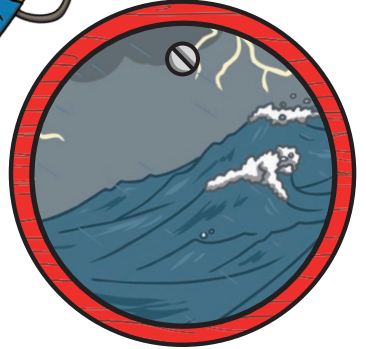
The Blue Fairy sent a dog to scare them off.

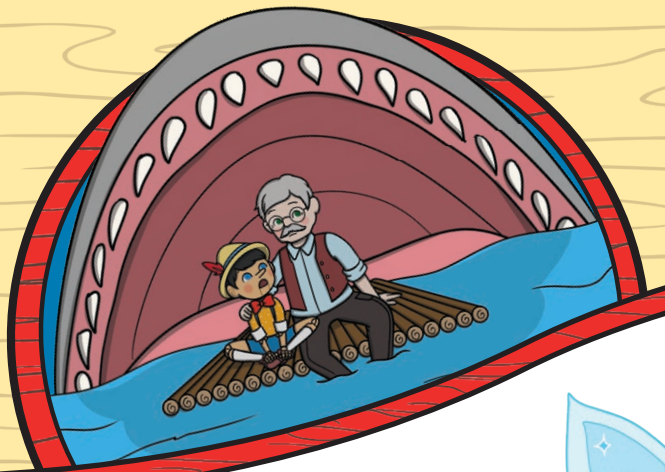


The Blue Fairy told Pinocchio that his nose would only shrink when he told the truth.
