'ge' and 'dge' Four in a Row



You will need:


- 2 players
- 1 board
- 30 counters 15 of one colour, 15 of another colour

How to Play:

- 1. One player goes first and picks a square. The player must read the 'ge' or 'dge' word.
- 2. If the player can read the word, they may put their counter on that square. If they cannot read the word, the square stays empty.
- 3. The other player picks a different square and reads the word on that square. If they can read the word, they may put their counter on that square.
- 4. The winner is the person who gets four of their counters in a row either vertically, horizontally or diagonally. The aim of the game is to block the other player while trying to achieve four in a row yourself.

Evidence Gathering

This game could also be played by circling the words with a coloured pencil. Each player would need a different coloured pen or pencil.

Try to get four of your counters in a row. They can go vertically, horizontally or diagonally.
