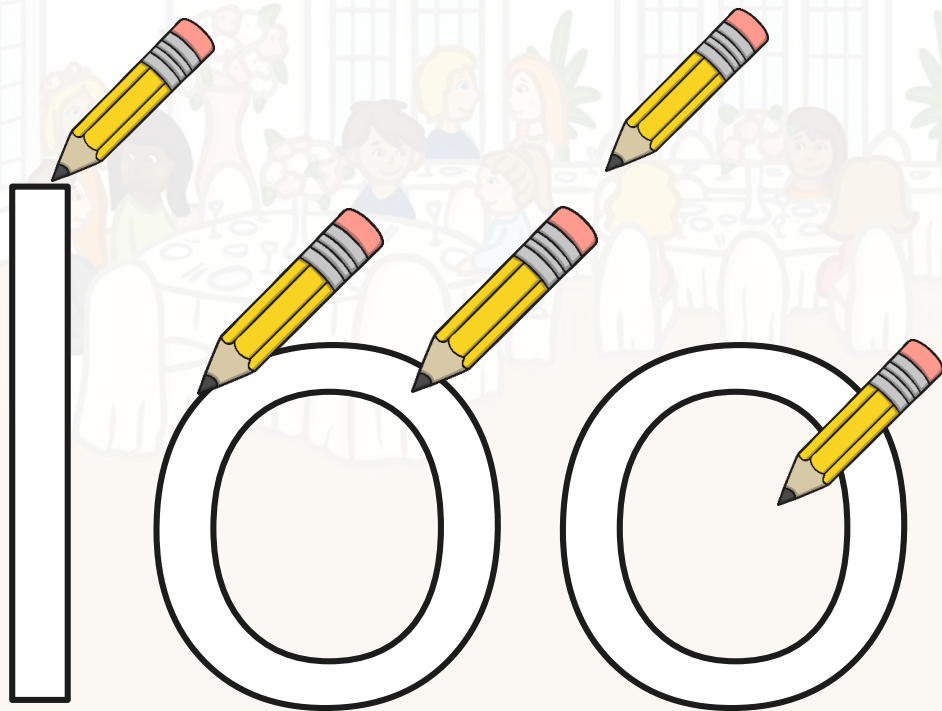

Today, we are learning to read words that contain **ue** saying /oo/.

We have already learnt that the 'ue' grapheme makes a /yoo/ sound as in 'due'. This grapheme can also make an /oo/ sound as in 'glue'.

Sometimes when we see **u** and **e** as partners, they make an /oo/ sound.
Let's try and say these together:

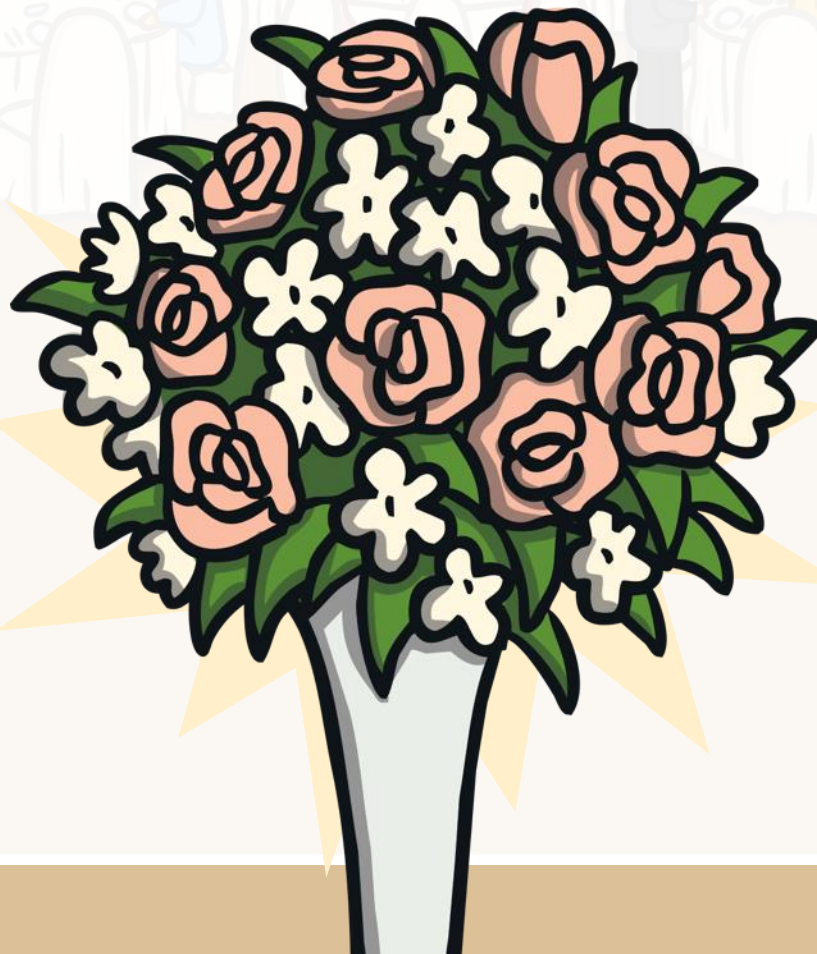

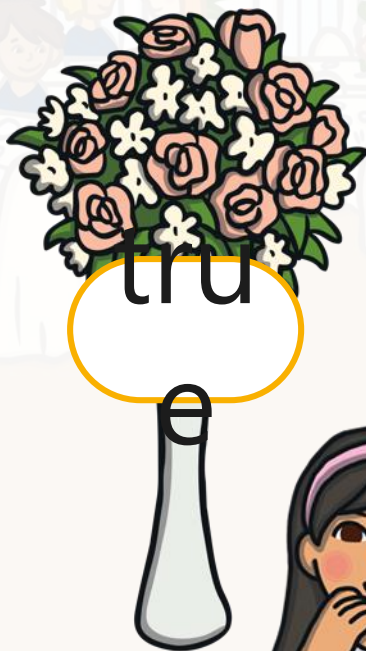
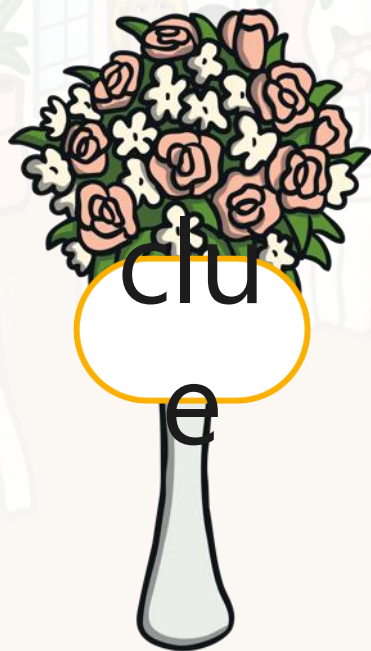

Click on each of the vases to reveal a word. Can you read them?

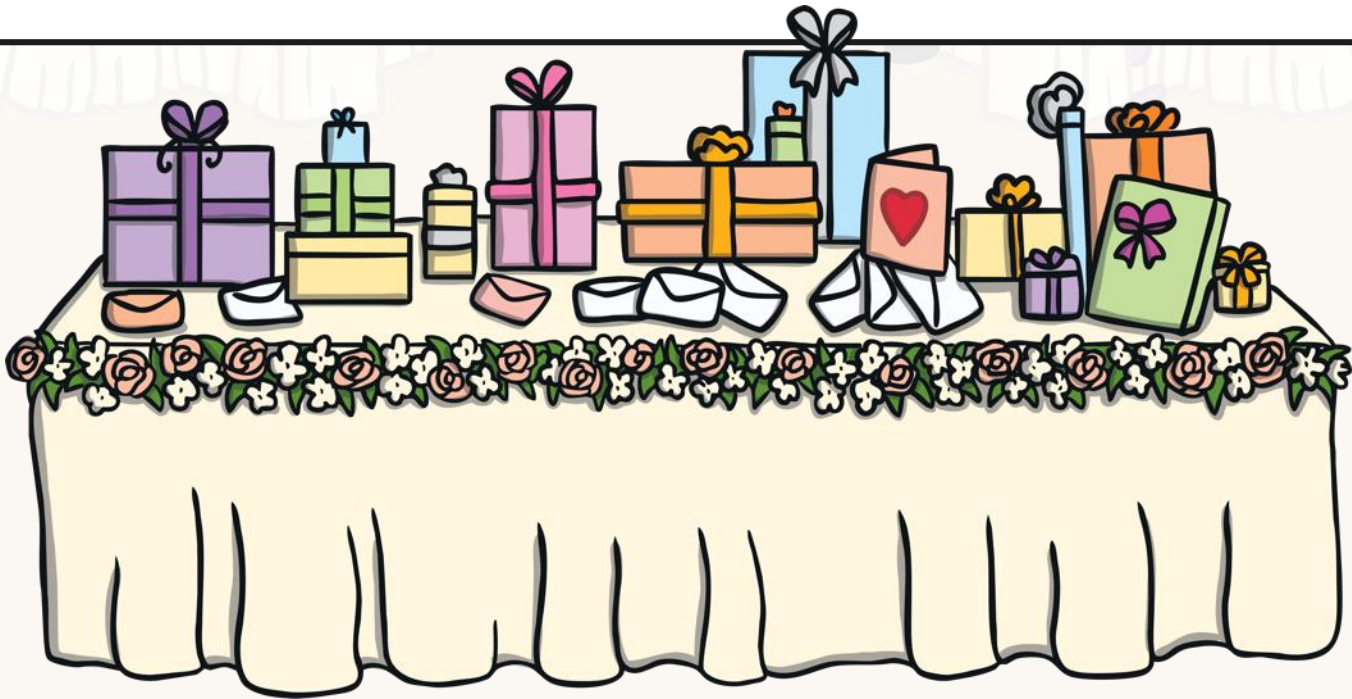




Special Message

Read the **ue** words and decide where they need to go.



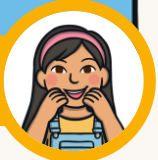
Dear Sue,
