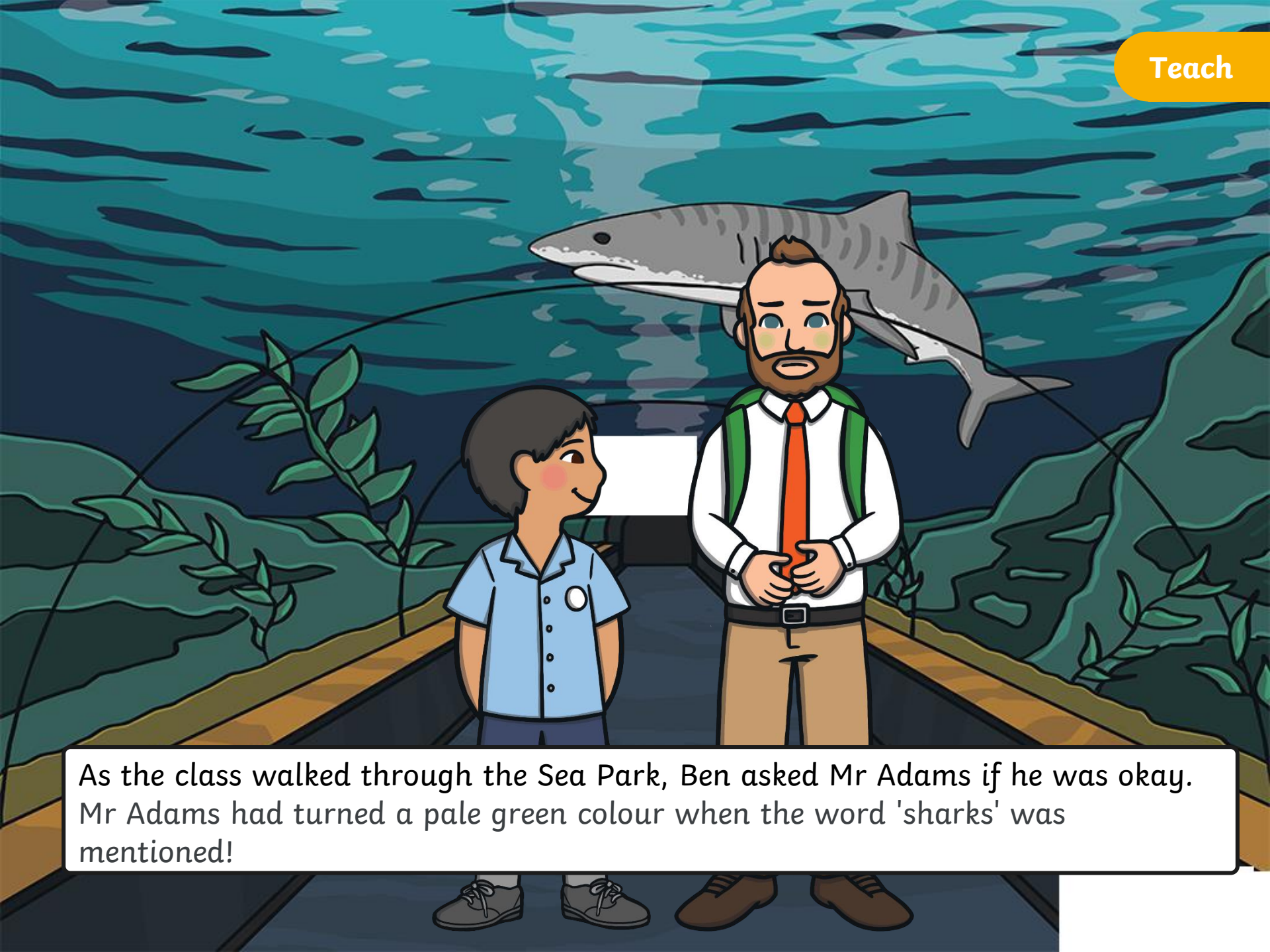

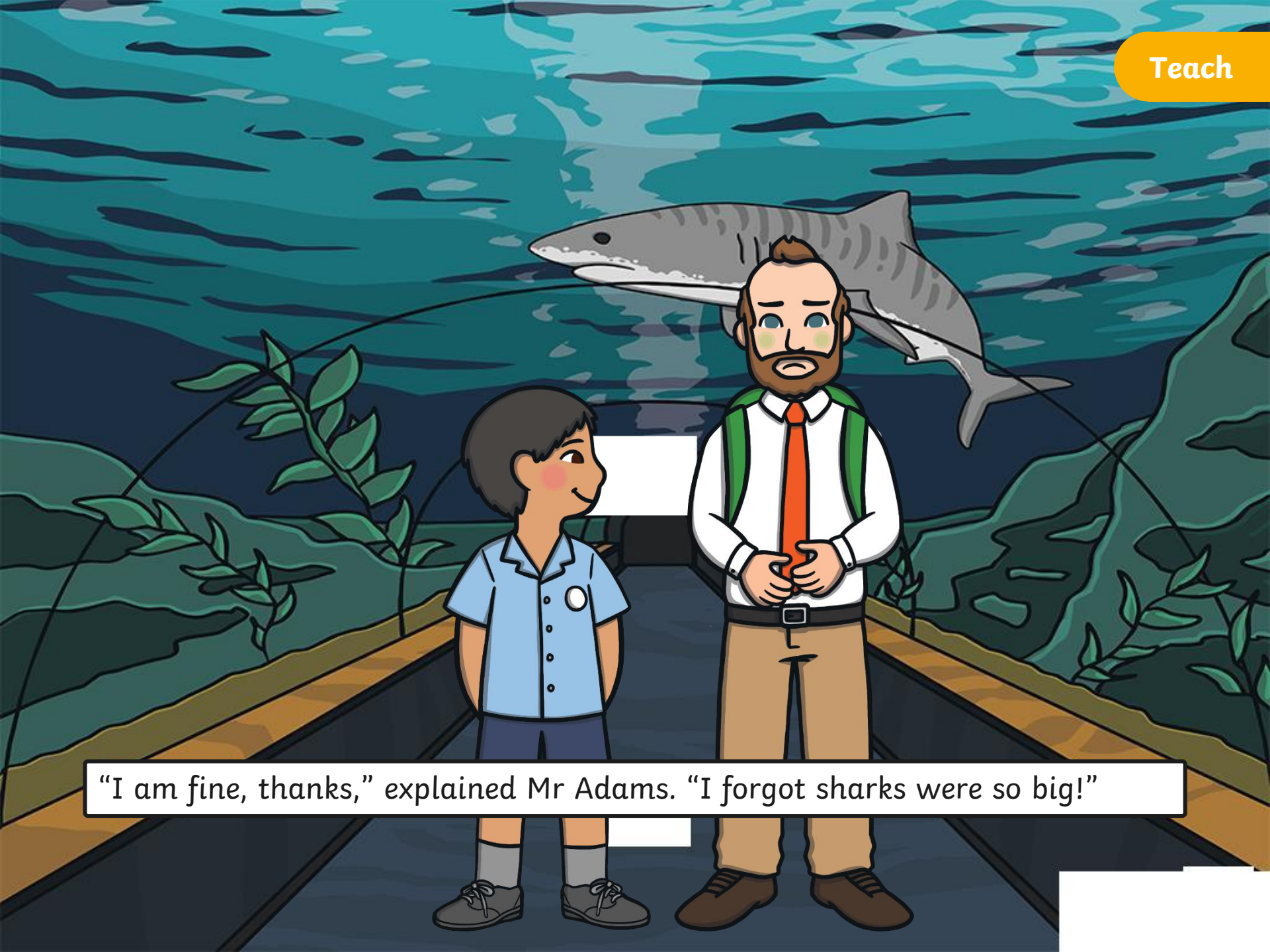


Today, we are learning to write words that contain **ea**.



“I am fine, thanks,” explained Mr Adams. “I forgot sharks were so big!”



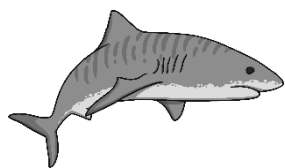
“I think sharks are awesome!” said Ben. “Whale sharks are the biggest. They are four times larger than an elephant! I told you I knew lots of facts.”

Hint: They are all **ea** words



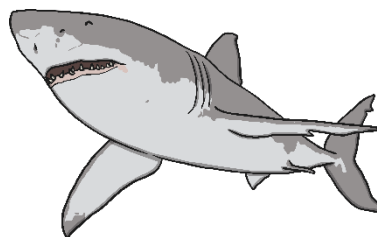
