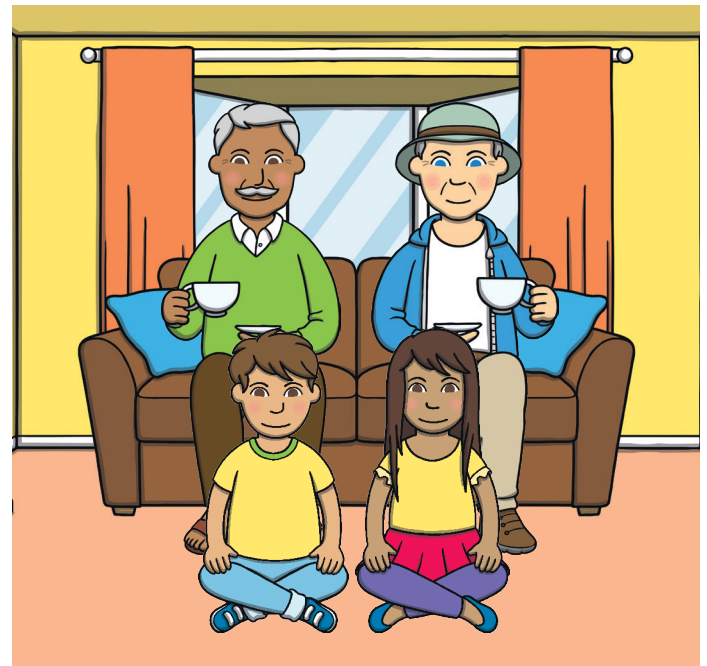

Q2: What did Kit and Sam decide to do to find out what 'chalk and talk' means?



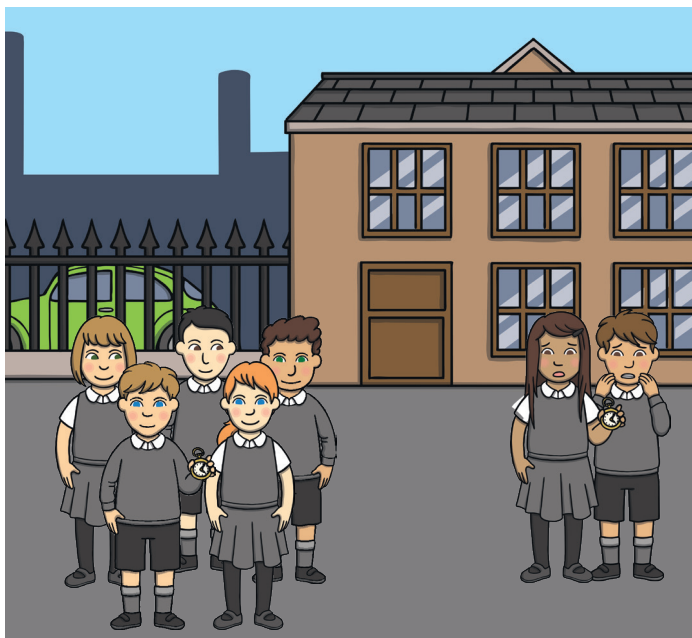

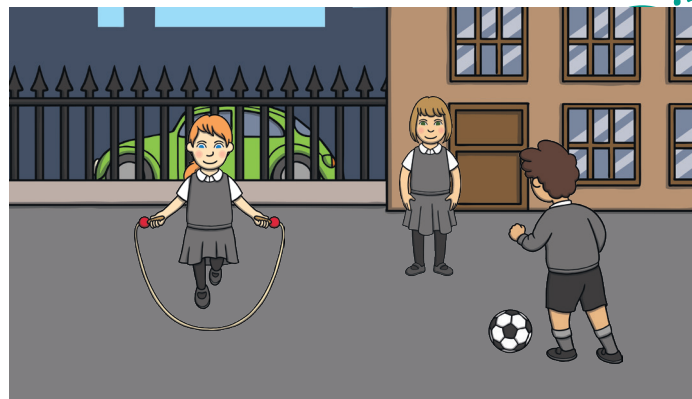

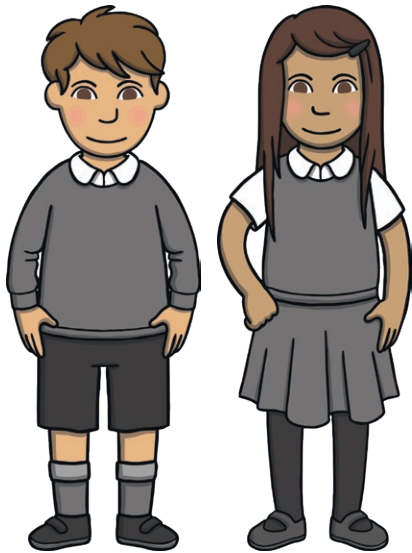
