

Noun Adjective Sets Word Cards

LO: I can use expanded noun phrases to describe and specify.

The idea is for learners to order suitable adjectives with a noun.

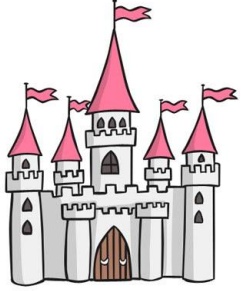
Cut up the sets of noun + adjectives.

Give the cards out to your group to sort into phrases.

Here are a few ways to use them:

1. Separate into sets of 4 cards so children only have to decide on the word order.
2. Have all the cards face up so children can choose one at a time to build phrases.
3. Play a sort of reverse Happy Families – children say which noun they have, and the next person round gives them an adjective they think will fit.
4. Once they have decided on the adjective/noun groups, experiment with the word order and vote on which they think sounds best.
