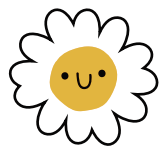

$$29 + 11 = 40 \text{ seashells}$$

$$45 - 19 = 26 \text{ bulldozers}$$

3. Derek went apple picking with his brother. Derek picked 12 apples and Todd picked 10. How many apples did they pick altogether?

$$12 + 10 = 22 \text{ apples}$$

4. Pat walked for 30 minutes. John walked for 15 minutes. How many more minutes did Pat walk?

$$30 - 15 = 15 \text{ minutes}$$

5. In May, it rained for 17 days. In June, it rained for 8 days. How many more days did it rain in May?

$$17 - 8 = 9 \text{ days}$$
