Technology Around Us: Technology in the Home

National Curriculum

Recognise common uses of information technology beyond school.

Aim

To recognise different types of technology in the home and understand why they are used.

Lesson Duration

It is estimated that this lesson will take approximately 60 minutes.



Success Criteria

I can recognise the difference between technology and information technology.

I can identify examples of information technology in the home.

I know why information technology is used in the home.

Prior Learning: From Lesson 1, children should be familiar with what technology is and should be able to name technology that they see or use around the school.

Learning Sequence



Remember It: Ask children to play a game of **Ping Pong** to recall items of technology in school. Each child takes it in turn to name an item before batting it across to their partner. How many different items can they name?





Technology in the Home: Use the images in the **Lesson Presentation** to encourage children to think about technology that they may have used in their homes today. Take feedback from children and use the opportunity to reinforce the concept that technology helps us to do things more easily.



Using the house cross-section, encourage children to start thinking about the technology used in different rooms within a house.





Technology in the Home Sorting Cards: Use the **Lesson Presentation** to introduce the **Technology in the Home Sorting Cards** activity to familiarise children with a wide range of technology found in the home. Encourage children to think about what each piece of technology is used for.





What Is Information Technology?: Use the **Lesson Presentation** to ensure that children understand the definition of information technology. Show examples of technology and spend time discussing the examples of information technology and how these are different from the other technologies shown.





Sort IT Out: Encourage children to recall previous learning by asking them to explain the special properties that are specific to information technology. Take feedback from the children before revealing the definition of information technology once again to reinforce understanding. Set children the challenge of sorting examples of technology and information technology using the differentiated **Sort IT Out Activity Sheets**.

Can children remember the special properties of information technology and apply these to real life examples?



Children sort the eight pictures of technology into the table.



Children sort the fifteen pictures of technology into the table.



Children record their own examples of technology and information technology into the table.



Why Do We Use It?: Share the examples of information technology included in the Lesson Presentation. Ask children to provide their own thoughts about why we use these items before revealing the answers provided.




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
