Inside the fish tank, the water is filled up almost to the top.


On the bottom of the tank, there is sand and there are three green plants.

What kind of event is this?


I think that this is a car race at a race track.

His eyes had blue face paint stars around them.


He had a big red smile.

There was a dome on top. Inside the glass dome were two aliens.


One was green and had one eye and lots of antennae. The other was purple.

His nose is just two holes. He is sticking his tongue out.


My monster has no arms but he does have two legs. On each foot, he has two toes.
