Prior Learning: Children need to know the spelling rules for adding -ed and -s. The children will need to understand the term verb and be able to identify verbs in a sentence.

## Learning Sequence

Introductory Activity - Simple Past or Simple Present? Ask pairs to talk to each other about the things they do each morning
and to identify the simple present verbs they used to talk about this. Show sentences on the Lesson Presentation of children
talking about what they did last weekend. Ask pairs to write down the simple past verbs used in these sentences on their
whiteboards. Discuss the simple past and the simple present and ask children to work in pairs to complete the Past or Present
Tense Sorting Activity Sheet using the Past or Present Sentences Sorting Cards. Can children identify sentences that are
written in the past tense?
