Main Clause

We will go to the fair

Put on your coat

I'd love a slice of cake

I'm going into town

You should sit down

Put a tick next to it

It should be fine

Subordinate Clause

provided that there is enough.

before it's too late.

because I'm bored.

unless I say otherwise.

if it gets cold.

until we get tired.

whenever you feel like it.
