

Noun Guides Craft Activity:

Teacher notes

LO: To name different types of nouns and give examples.

Description:

In this activity, children will make their own reference books which explain the five different types of noun: abstract, collective, proper, compound and common.

The activity uses two A4 pieces of paper, which are stuck together in the middle and cut along the dashed edges to make flaps.

Inside the noun guide children will find their own examples of the noun types, writing the nouns down with an accompanying illustration either drawn by hand or cut out from a magazine.

Differentiation:

- Children could either write their own definitions of the noun types or be provided with them.
- Lower ability children could be given a word bank of easyto-read nouns and can decide from these which nouns fit into the different noun types.




