



Part B

- 1. What reasons did George give in the story for 'being bored to tears'?
 - George complained that he did not have brother s or sisters or any other children to play with. He is fed up with looking at animals and having only his grandma for company.
- 2. What adjectives and noun phrases describe how Grandma looked in Chapter 1?
 - Example answer: 2. 'She had pale brown teeth and a small puckered-up mouth like a dog's bottom'.
- 3. What adjectives and noun phrases describe Grandma's personality in Chapter 1?
 - Example answer: In Chapter I Grandma is described as a 'selfish, grumpy old woman. Complaining, grousing, grouching, grumbling, griping. She was a miserable old grouch.'
- 4. What did Grandma say was the matter with George?
 - Grandma said that George was growing too fast and that boys who grow too fast become stupid and lazy.
- 5. What did George think Grandma could be and why do you think he thought that?
 - Example answer: George thought Grandma could be a witch because she was saying horrible things to frighten him.
