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Vocabulary

- Create a vocabulary line for George's Marvellous
 Medicine, that looks like a timeline. Label one end
 'good adjectives' and the furthest end 'amazing
 adjectives'. Collect adjectives from today's chapters
 and decide on the effect of the vocabulary by putting
 each word carefully on the line according to your
 opinion about how great the word is.
- Challenge! Create a mini dictionary using the words collected so far. Use an existing dictionary if you need to.
