Interview a Character Answers

Interviewer: Hello, Achoo. I wanted to ask you about the events of tonight, please.

I understand people are looking for your daughter right now but if

Achoo: I only have a moment. I want to be out looking again very quickly.

Interviewer: Yes, of course. Can you tell me about the omen you all saw before

you went to bed last night?

Achoo: (helpful words: Ritual, sky, red, Long Frost) It was the most bizarre sight. The sky looked really strange and the sun was a bright, dazzling red colour. Example answers:
