#### Part A

- 1. Why does Bee have to follow the Pig Lick River? (p. 70)
  - Bee follows the Pig Lick River because it is the only way she knows to get to the Rock of the Long Sun and find her tribe.

  - Bee wears her bearskin and mask to scare off any more cave bears.
- 3. Why does Bee decide not to wear her bearskin and mask on the second day of walking? Give two reasons. (p. 70-71)
  - a) It is too hot to wear the bearskin.
  - b) The bearskin is starting to smell funny.
