Vocabulary

- Draw a picture of the park based on the description in Chapter 5.
- **Challenge!** Can you label your drawing with your own noun phrases to describe different features of the park?



Create

- In pairs, create a suitable habitat for a hedgehog using an empty box. If you are allowed to, try and collect suitable items from outside your classroom.
- **Challenge!** Write a note beginning with 'Dear Mr Hedgehog...' to welcome a creature to its new home.



Predict

- Think about the story so far and how they think the story will end. Will Max ever find a safe place to cross? **Complete Prediction Activity Sheet.**
- **Challenge!** Write your own ending to the story. Try and explain what you think will happen to Max and his family.



Research

- Use books and/or the Internet to research what a typical hedgehog habitat is like. Where do they prefer to live in the wild? Why?
- **Challenge!** Draw a picture of an ideal hedgehog habitat and label the key details.
