

Comprehension Answers

Part A

- 1. What did Max learn about lorries? (page 17)

- 3. Why did Max get his words in a muddle?
 - Max got his words in a muddle because he had hit his head on the kerbstone.

 - Max called himself a 'hodgeheg' because he got his words in a muddle after being hit on the head.
- 5. What did Max's sisters do to make him feel better?
 - Max's sisters gave him slugs and played with him to make him feel better.

 - Example answers: Max was probably feeling excited, nervous or happy, e.g. Max was feeling nervous as he knew he was going to attempt to cross the road.

- 3. Why did the cyclist 'pedal sadly away?'
