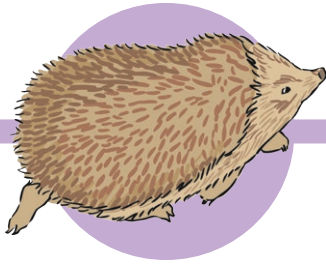

Vocabulary

Predict

- **Challenge!** Discuss your predictions in your reading groups. What evidence from the text supports your predictions?



Research

Think

- Make a list of three different activities that a hedgehog might find trickier than a human. Explain why each one is tricky for a hedgehog.
- **Challenge!** Writing as if you are Max, design a guide for hedgehogs, which explains five handy survival tips.
