A writing model can be one way to support learners with the conventions involved in writing for different audiences and different purposes.

Our exemplar texts save teachers time by providing model texts that can be used as 'walk through guides' for their learners.

The texts can be used with the whole class as an explicit teaching tool to model the conventions of a particular text type. The exemplar texts could also be used for display and individual reference, making them versatile in your classroom. They might also be helpful when explaining the writing progress to parents during conferences.

Each exemplar text in this series highlights a different text type.

In addition to the modelled text, you will find key writing features, language and structures of the text type highlighted (in brackets) throughout the exemplar. This allows you to show your learners what each of these features looks like in writing and how they work together to create a whole text.
