Tips for Use:

The alphabetizing practice pages include two options: cut-and-paste or writing the words.

- Cut and paste pages allow students to manipulate the words before gluing them in place. They are also useful for students with writing difficulties.
- Writingpages
- a. Easier: Words can still be cut apart, manipulated, then written
- b. Challenge: Students transfer the words without cutting them out.

This resource also includes Challenge Task Cards.

- Cards I-2 "Find the Error"
 - Each list is alphabetized except for one word that is out of order. When the word
 is removed, the list will be correct.
 - Have the students find the word to be removed and record it on the answer sheet
- Cards 3-4 "Complete the List"
 - These cards stretch the students' thinking by having them add words that would correctly fit into the empty spaces. They must pay attention to the word before and after the blanks to maintain ABC order. *Answers will vary*. The answer key provides a list of beginning letters that can be used to help with scoring the sheets.

Recording Sheets

 They are pre-numbered so challenge cards can be mixed for practice without having to worry about students misnumbering their answers and to make scoring easier.

Differentiation:

- Choose the number of words that meet the needs of your students—some may need
 to start with fewer words, while others may be ready to move ahead to longer lists.
- Allow students to use the <u>alphabet strips</u> as they learn alphabetical order. For students who are ready, remove the lists to make the tasks a mental challenge.
- Some students may need to work with partners.
- Allow students to use <u>dictionaries</u> for the "Complete the List" challenge cards. (Many online dictionaries offer the option for searching for words that "begin with" certain letters.)
