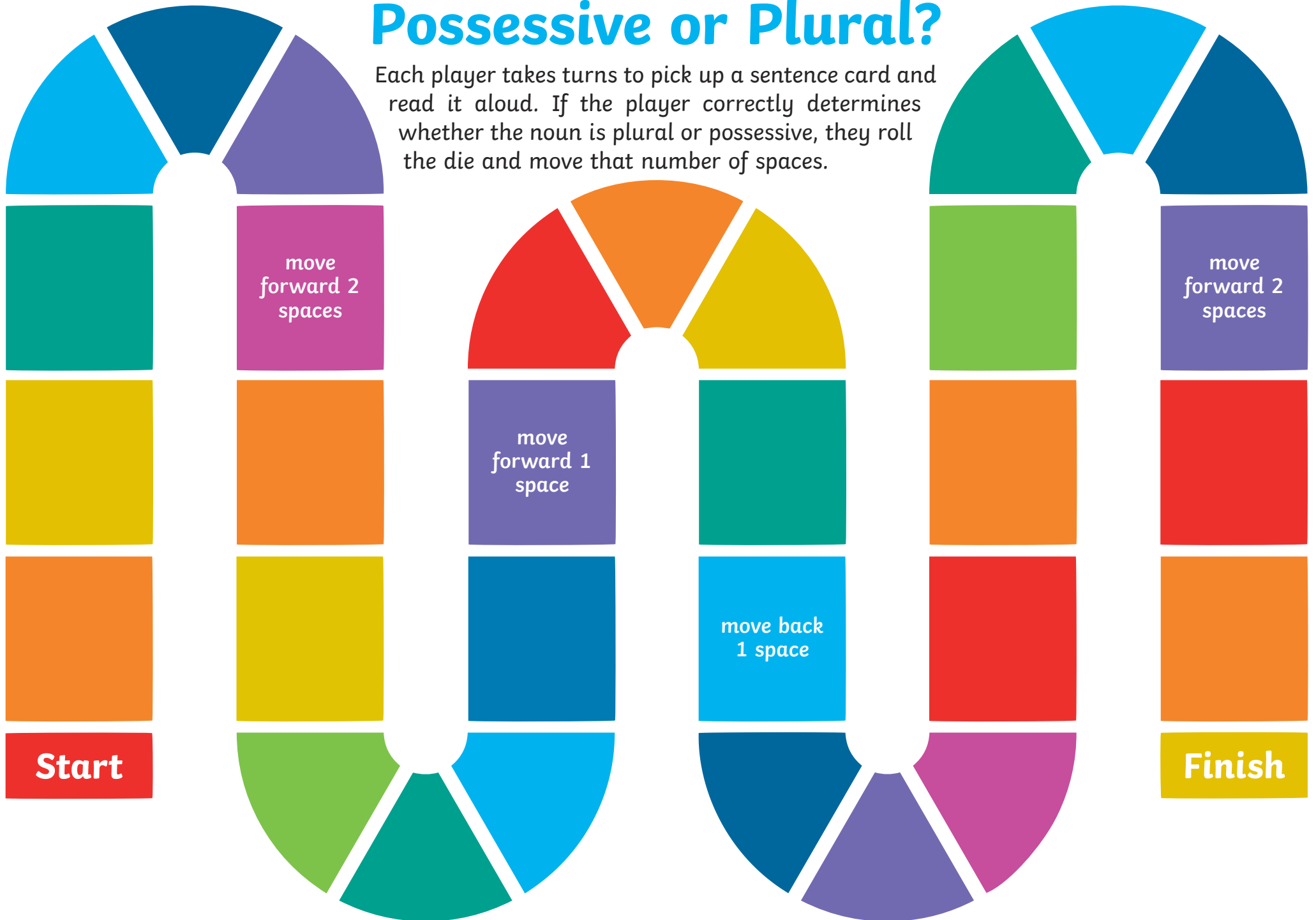


Possessive or Plural?

Each player takes turns to pick up a sentence card and read it aloud. If the player correctly determines whether the noun is plural or possessive, they roll the die and move that number of spaces.
