How can I use this with my children?

Use the poster showing the months of the year with seasonal pictures to encourage your child to answer the questions on the worksheet and to carry out the cut and paste activity to order the months.

How does this help my children's learning?

In years 1 and 2, your child will consolidate learning on the months of the year and will think about how many days are in each month, as well as what leap years are. The activities in this pack can help to reinforce this.

Ideas for further learning:

Learning rhymes and songs are a great way for children to remember things by heart. Try singing the months of the year to a tune or chant the rhyme: 30 days has September, April June and November.






