A noun is a word that names a person, place, object or idea.





Understanding Nouns and Pronouns

A pronoun is a word that takes the place of a noun.

There are seven types of pronouns, which are used for different purposes.

| Personal Pronouns These represent people, places and things. | Possessive Pronouns These show ownership and replace possessive noun phrases. | Relative Pronouns These link one part of a sentence to another by introducing a relative clause that describes an earlier noun or pronoun. | Reflexive Pronouns These refer back to an earlier noun or pronoun in a sentence, so the performing and receiving of an action apply to the same person or thing. | Demonstrative Pronouns These function as subjects of objects in a sentence, replacing nouns. | Interrogative Pronouns These are used to ask questions and represent an unknown subject or object. | Indefinite Pronouns These do not refer to any specific person or thing, but take the place of nouns in a sentence. |
