# Punctuating Direct Speech Answers

## Part A

1. The boy “shouted, Go away!”
  - *The boy shouted, “Go away!”*
2. I don’t understand “said the dolphin.”
  - *“I don’t understand,” said the dolphin.*
3. The driver asked “Which way?”
  - *The driver asked, “Which way?”*
4. “can you tell me where the errors are?” queried the student.
  - *“Can you tell me where the errors are?” queried the student.*

## Part B

1. The boy “shouted, Go away!” No replied his brother
  - *The boy shouted, “Go away!”*
  - *“No!” replied his brother.*
2. I don’t understand “said the dolphin. We only stopped for five minutes”
  - *“I don’t understand,” said the dolphin. “We only stopped for five minutes.”*
3. The driver asked “Which way? “Straight ahead and then third left. called the passenger.
  - *The driver asked, “Which way?”*
  - *“Straight ahead and then third left,” called the passenger.*

What are the rules when punctuating direct speech?

- *Spoken words are enclosed in inverted commas.*
- *Use a reporting clause to say who is speaking.*
- *Punctuation inside inverted commas.*
- *Use a comma after the reporting clause if it is written before the speech.*
- *Each new speaker needs a new line.*
- *The speech of each new speaker starts with a capital letter.*
