Personal Pronouns:

- These represent people, places and things.
- I, you, he, she, it, we, you, they (subject), me, you, him, her, it, us, you, them (object).
- e.g. She gave him a piano lesson.

Possessive Pronouns:

- These show ownership and replace possessive noun phrases.
- mine, yours, his, hers, its, ours, yours, theirs
- e.g. The piano is his.
