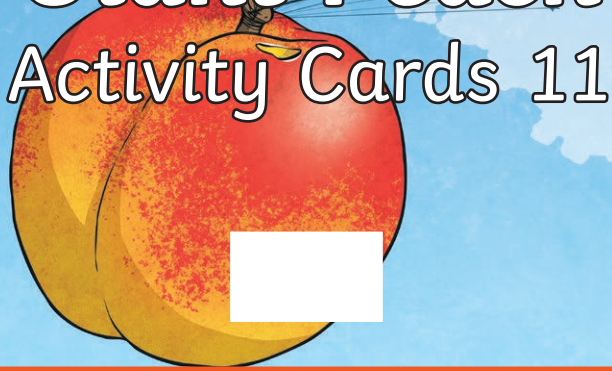

### Punctuation and Grammar

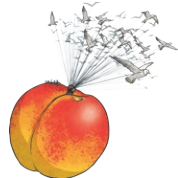
- Complete the **Apostrophes to Mark Plural Possession Activity Sheet**.

## James and the Giant Peach Activity Cards

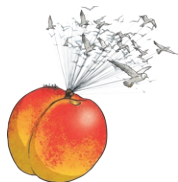
### Vocabulary

- **Challenge!** Compare this speed to other methods of travel.



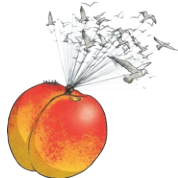
## Imagine
