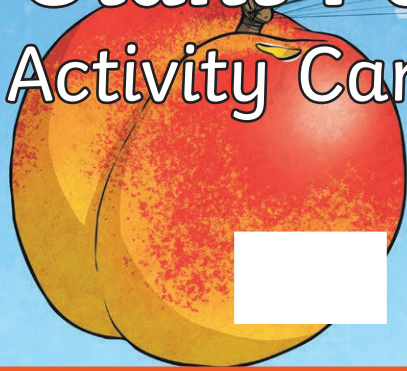

Punctuation and Grammar

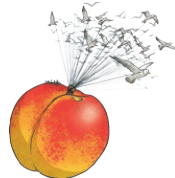
- James grows an enormous peach. Can you find some more examples in the text of the determiner 'an' being used? Can you describe when it needs to be used?

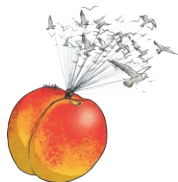
Vocabulary

- **Challenge!** Make up some zany animal names of your own.



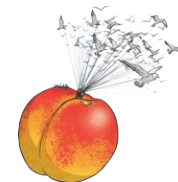
Review

- **Challenge!** What is your favourite Roald Dahl story? Write an argument supporting your opinion.



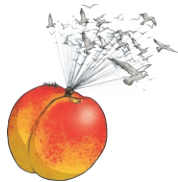
Discuss
