### Reading Questions and Answers

#### Page 7

**What does the word 'herding' mean?**

- The word 'herding' means looking after sheep, or making them move in a certain direction.

#### Page 9

**What word gives us a clue about how Romulus and Remus felt about each other? What does this word mean?**

- The word that gives us a clue about how Romulus and Remus felt about each other is 'beloved'. The word means loved deeply.

**The author describes Romulus' cheeks as having 'burned bright red'. What other phrases could have been used?**

- Example answers: Glowed scarlet.

**What does the word 'resolutely' mean?**

- The word 'resolutely' means in a determined way.

**What type of word is 'uncontrollably'?**

- The word 'uncontrollably' is an adverb.

**How does the author describe Romulus?**

- The author described Romulus as having 'bright red' cheeks, 'shaking uncontrollably' and having 'fierce teeth'.



### Deeper Reading

**Which words tell us what kind of person Romulus is? How do these words help us to work out what Romulus might do next?**

- Words that tell us what kind of person Romulus is include 'shaking uncontrollably', 'he gritted his fierce teeth' and 'resolutely'. These words show that he gets angry and is very determined. It shows that Romulus isn't afraid to fight for what he wants.
