Part A

Part B

Rewrite this passage in the present tense.

The twins turn down the crown because they want to found their own city. The twins leave their hometown in search of a place to build their perfect city. They eventually come to the place where Rome is located today. They both like the general area, except they both want to build the city on a different hill. Romulus wants the city to be on top of Palatine Hill while Remus prefers Aventine Hill.

It may useful to point out that 'found' remains as it is - children may be confused and assume it is the past tense of 'find' as opposed to the meaning 'to start a city'. There must be subject/verb agreement, e.g. 'wants' and 'want'.
