

How can I use this with my children?


Once they've read the relevant chapters in the **Homework Help** area, children can complete this quiz to test their understanding of the topic.

Ancient Egyptians Quiz for Kids




1.	What is the name of the river that was important to the ancient Egyptians in terms of




How many questions did you get correct? Check your answers below.
