If the root word ends in an 'e' (but not 'ate'), drop the 'e' when -ation is added.

If the root word ends in 'ate', drop the 'ate' when –ation is added.

organise + ation = organisation

adore + ation = adoration

concentrate + ation =
 concentration

exaggerate + ation = exaggeration
