Amy needed to make a **decision** about what to do.

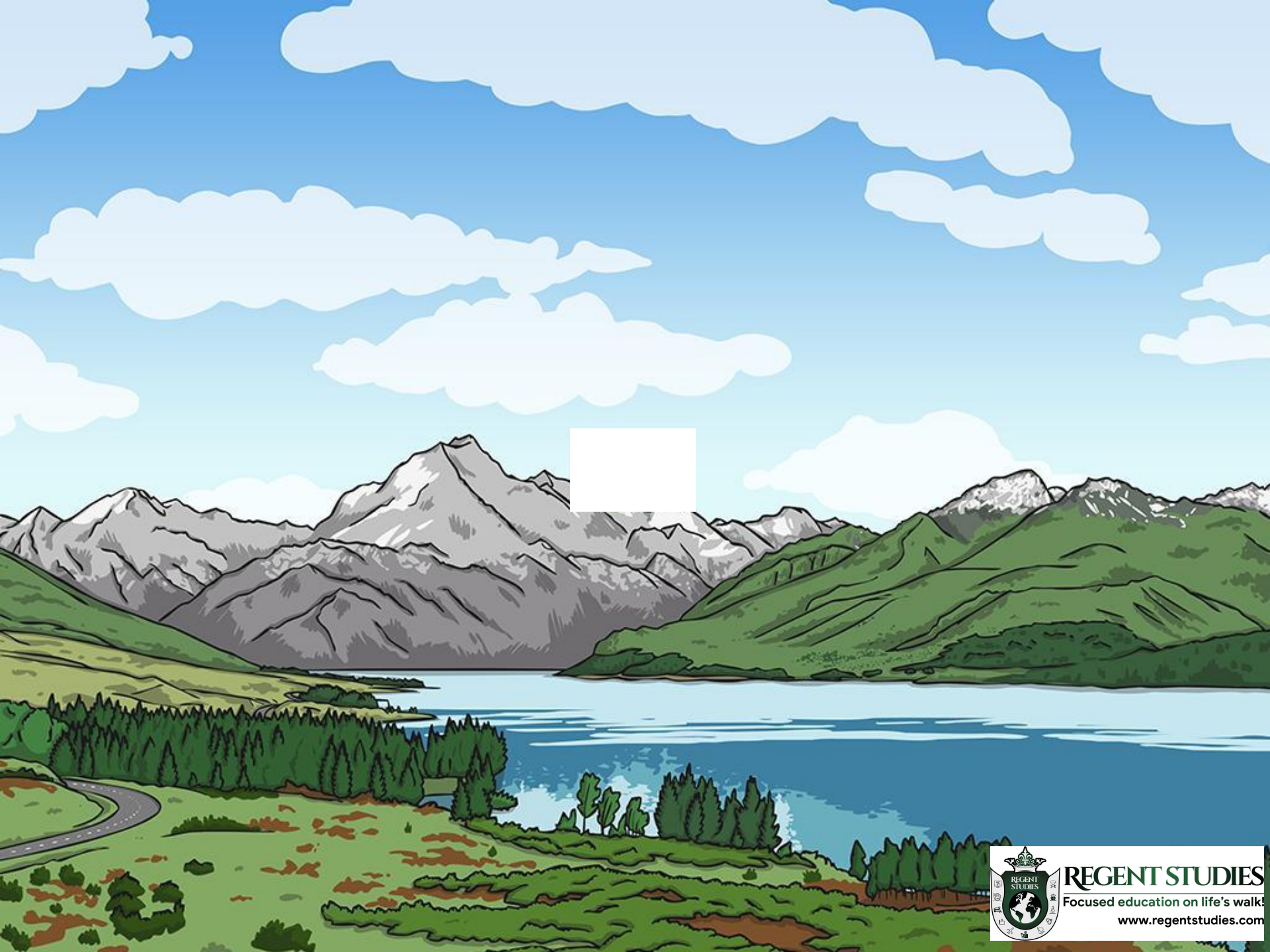
Children often enjoy watching **television**.
