Suffixes **Rule 1**

When a word ends with a **short vowel sound**
and a **single consonant**....

...double the final consonant.

clap → clapped

win → winning

flat → flatten

Suffixes Rule 2

When a word ends in silent 'e',
drop the 'e' IF...
...the suffix begins with a vowel...



Can you think of any more?

Suffixes Rule 3

When a word ends in silent 'e',

keep the 'e' **IF...**

...the suffix begins with a consonant...

taste → taste**less**

love → love**ly**

hope → hope**ful**

Suffixes **Rule 4**

When a word ends in 'ce' or 'ge',

keep the 'e' IF...

...the suffix begins with 'a' or 'o'.
