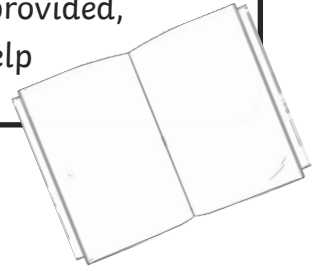


# Story Starter Activity Template
