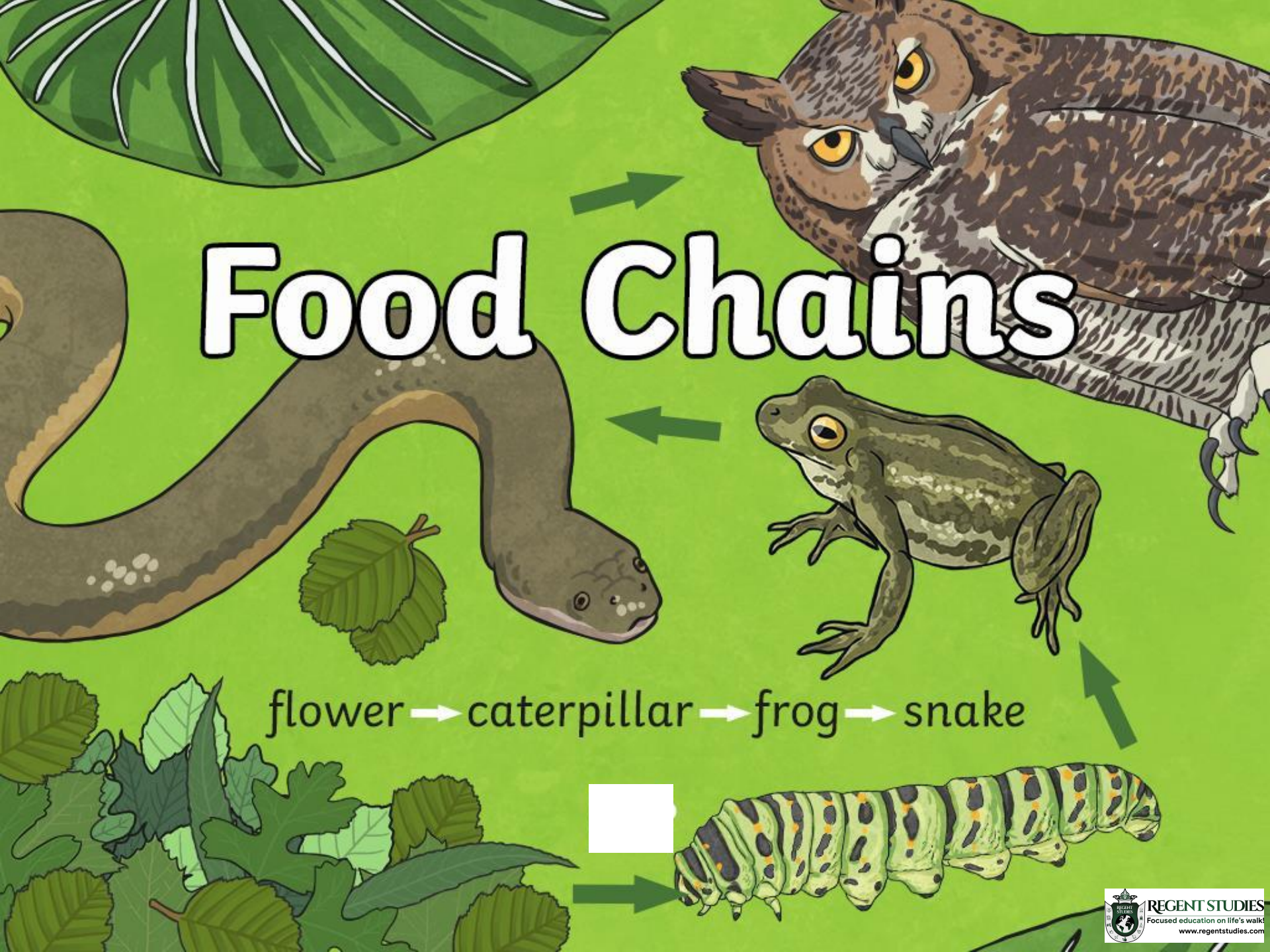

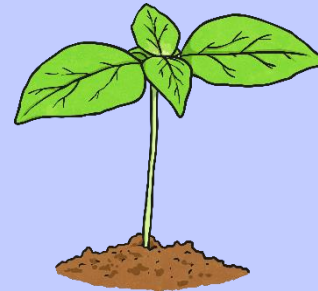

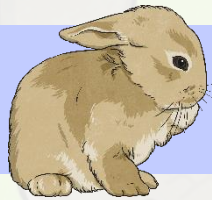
Consumers or Producer?

lettuce



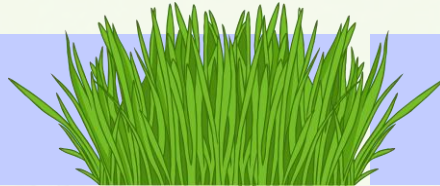

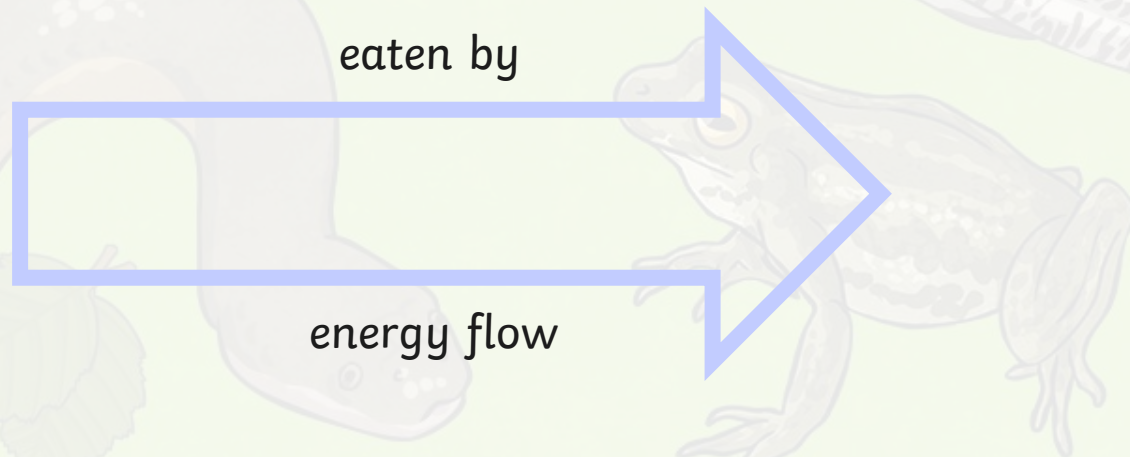
