








**Animal Flow Chart** 






### **Classification Keys: Sample Questions**







## Aim

• To use a classification key to group living things.

### **Success Criteria**

- To identify a variety of living things in the local environment
- To create a classification key.




Classification keys are a way of identifying living things through a series of questions.

For example:







Each question has a **yes** or **no** answer and leads you one step closer to the name of a living thing.



The first question is always quite general because it needs to help sort the living things you are classifying.





The questions will gradually get more specific as they separate living things that are more similar.



# Activity

First, have a go at putting the living things in the correct boxes in the **Variation Worksheet**.





Second, have a go at creating your own yes or no questions that will identify the living things on the **Animal Flow Chart Worksheet**.

You can use the sample questions to help you.




Can you make a classification key for 4 of the living things you found? The first question has been made for you.
