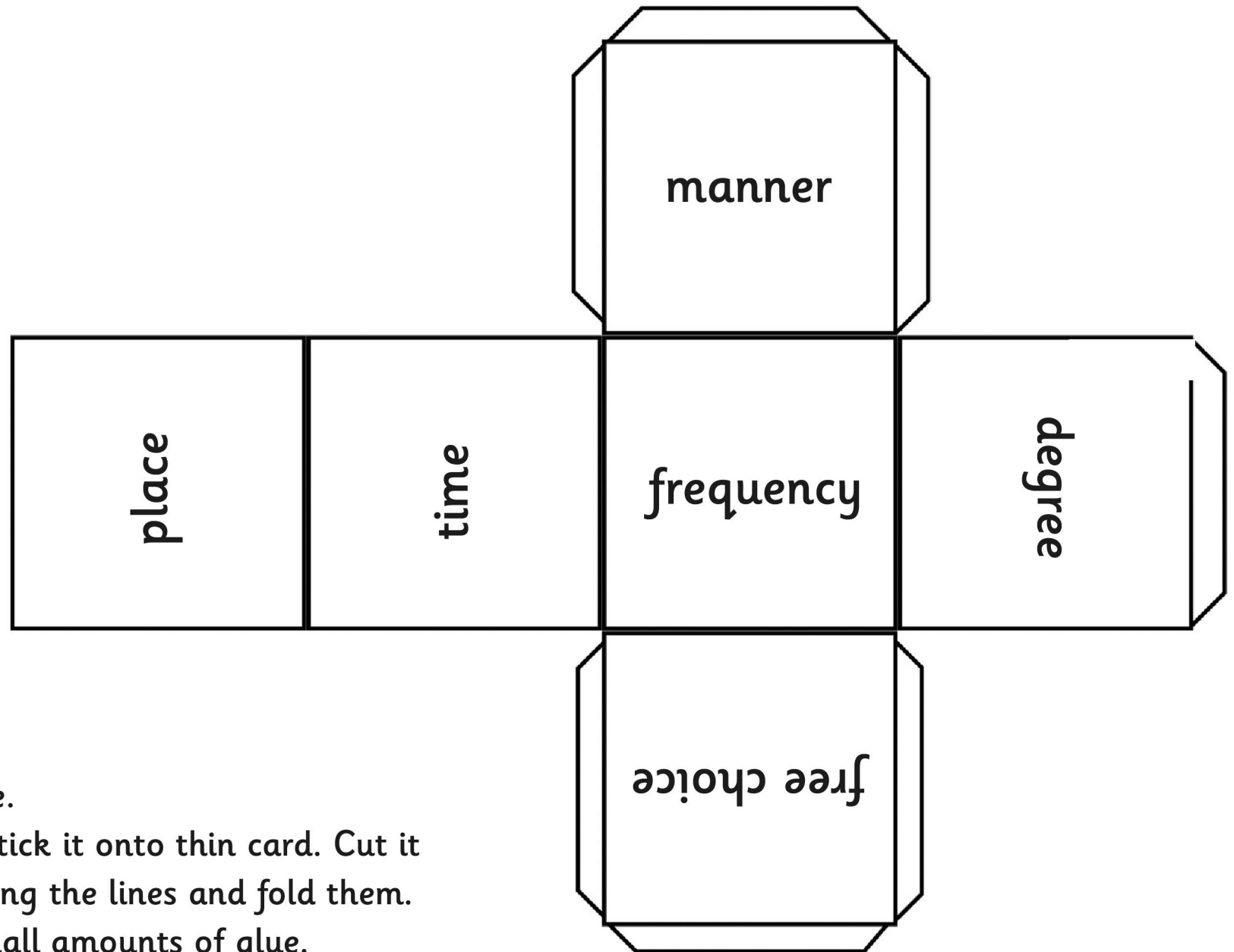


# Fronted Adverbials Dice Game
